It is an incontrovertible fact that almost all of what we nowadays call folk songs existed at some point in their evolution on cheaply printed thin sheets of paper we generally refer to as broadsides. In fact many of our folk songs first saw the light of day on some sort of street literature.

The Broadside Ballad

Broadside ballads appeared shortly after the invention of printing in the 15th century and were hawked in streets, fairs, and marketplaces of Europe into the 19th century. Typical broadsides included hack-written topical ballads on recent crimes, executions, or disasters. Many ballads passed into the oral tradition from broadside origins.
