Broadly speaking, performance assessment is any learning activity or assessment thatasks students to perform or showcase their learning in order to demonstrate their knowledge, understanding and/or competencies, usually in a real-world context. It is often a key component of high-quality student-centered learning. Tom Vander Ark stated:

Performance Assessment in Different Learning Environments

In general, a performance-based assessment measures students' ability to apply the skills and knowledge learned from a unit or units of study. Typically, the task challenges students to use their higher-order thinking skills to create a product or complete a process (Chun, 2010).

A performance-based assessment measures a student ' s ability to apply the skills learned in an authentic way. The purpose of performance-based assessments is to determine a student ' s strengths or highlight a particular skill. A rubric may give some structure to this type of assessment. However, performance assessments typically allow for high levels of student input and creativity.
