What is also typical for Williams' s heroines is that they are not able to deal with their past, the problems of their history is growing stronger and is rooted in their everyday life. Consequently, those women of various ages are stuck with the life in a state of current crisis. The hopelessness and the mediocrity of the characters in Williams' The Glass Menagerie is caused by a serious breach between the characters' feelings and their ability to verbalize the emotions.
