Birth records are also available from the local Registrar of Vital Statistics where the event occurred. Requirements Who is eligible to get a copy of a birth certificate? The person named on the birth certificate. A parent of the person named on the birth certificate. The requesting parent's name must be on the birth certificate.

Birth Certificates - New York State Department of Health

The Health Department mails birth certificates for newborns to parents about a month after the child's birth at no charge. The NYC Office of Vital Records is unable to provide information about your child's birth certificate before then. If you haven't received the certificate within four weeks, call 311 to ask for the status.

Birth Certificates - NYC Health

Applications for a Vital Record. Due to the impacts of COVID-19 our processing times for applications through the mail are 8 weeks from the time they are received in the Office of Vital Records. If you need your records faster, you are strongly encouraged to utilize the Express Delivery option or to check for walk-in locations near you for current hours of operation.

Applications for a Vital Record – Vital Records

Application to correct or complete a certificate must be made to the clerk of the city or town in which the event occurred. The fee for making a correction on a certificate is \$10. This fee must accompany the application. If a certified copy of the record is desired, there is an additional fee of \$15. per copy.

To place a record on file, complete the application and submit it to Vital Records with \$40 (includes the filing and issuance of one certified copy) and a copy of your photo ID along with the two (2) required documents listed above.

Birth Certificates - Health Department

Birth records are public information 100 years after the date of the event; death, marriage, and divorce records, 25 years after the event. Vital Records are available to immediate family members only- mother, father, husband, wife, child, brother, sister and grandparents with valid ID. Birth records can be issued to the legal guardian with proof of custody papers. Aunts, uncles, cousins, in-laws, etc. cannot obtain a Vital Record.

You must be an eligible applicant. Eligible applicants must be 18 years of age or older and include the following: Person named on the birth certificate. Spouse. Parent or step-parent. A step-parent must also submit a marriage certificate to support the relationship to the person named on the birth certificate.

Vital Records Forms Note: All applicants must provide a photocopy or show a valid government, school or employer issued photo identification. Applications without proper identification will be rejected and not processed.

For many Americans, the birth certificate is a mundane piece of paper, unearthed from deep storage when applying for a driver's license, verifying information for new employers, or claiming state and federal benefits. Yet as Donald Trump and his fellow "birthers" reminded us when they claimed that Barack Obama wasn't an American citizen, it plays a central role in determining identity and citizenship. In *The Birth Certificate: An American History*, award-winning historian Susan J. Pearson traces the document's two-hundred-year history to explain when, how, and why birth certificates came to matter so much in

the United States. Deftly weaving together social, political, and legal history, *The Birth Certificate* is a fascinating biography of a piece of paper that grounds our understanding of how those who live in the United States are considered Americans.

The delivery of high quality and equitable care for both mothers and newborns is complex and requires efforts across many sectors. The United States spends more on childbirth than any other country in the world, yet outcomes are worse than other high-resource countries, and even worse for Black and Native American women. There are a variety of factors that influence childbirth, including social determinants such as income, educational levels, access to care, financing, transportation, structural racism and geographic variability in birth settings. It is important to reevaluate the United States' approach to maternal and newborn care through the lens of these factors across multiple disciplines. *Birth Settings in America: Outcomes, Quality, Access, and Choice* reviews and evaluates maternal and newborn care in the United States, the epidemiology of social and clinical risks in pregnancy and childbirth, birth settings research, and access to and choice of birth settings.

Vital statistics, the records of birth and death, are a critical national information resource for understanding public health. Over the past few decades, the specific program that gathers the data has evolved into a complex cooperative program between the federal and state governments for social measurement. The Vital Statistics Cooperative Program (VSCP) is currently maintained by the National Center for Health Statistics (NCHS). The U.S. vital statistics system relies on the original information reported by myriad individuals, channeled through varying state and local information systems, and coordinated and processed by a federal statistical agency that has experienced relatively flat funding for many years. The challenges facing the vital statistics system and the continuing importance of the resulting data make it an important topic for examination. A workshop, held by the National Academies and summarized in this volume, considered the importance of adequate vital statistics. In particular, the workshop assessed both current and emerging uses of the data, considered the methodological and organizational features of compiling vital data, and identified possible visions for the vital statistics program.

Disparities in health and health care across racial, ethnic, and socioeconomic backgrounds in the United States are well documented. The reasons for these disparities are, however, not well understood. Current data available on race, ethnicity, SEP, and accumulation and language use are severely limited. The report examines data collection and reporting systems relating to the collection of data on race, ethnicity, and socioeconomic position and offers recommendations.
